****Average snow depth recorded is uncompressed.** Snowmobile openings are based on the snowpack's ability to protect underlying vegetation and include: depth measurements, snow density, wind loading, temperatures, forecast, terrain, topography, elevation, and snow base and ice conditions. Conditions update:

The past week saw about 7" of new snow and much warmer temperatures. Highs have been in the upper 20's the last few days and lows in the teens. The previous few weeks had temps as low as -20. All main snowmachine and ski trails have been groomed and are in great condition! The East Swamp Trail to Butterfly lake is open to snow machine or ATV under 1500 lbs. **NO HIGHWAY VEHICLES PERMITTED.**

ALL AREAS NORTH OF NANCY LAKE PARKWAY ARE CLOSED TO MOTORIZED USE, with the exception of the West Rolly Lake Motorized Corridor.

Nancy Lake Parkway is closed at the Winter Trail-head mile 2.2.

A \$5 day-use fee or annual parking pass is required at most trailheads throughout the park. Please respect private properties adjacent to park land. Please check the Alaska State Parks website or call 745-8950 for current conditions.

All snowmobiles must have their current registration tags displayed when used on public lands.
