**Conditions update:**

Last week a warming trend settled into the area and most if not all of the thin forming ice on the lakes is gone. A light dusting of snow fell, just enough to see animal tracks. Recreating is still very good right now, as all the trails and roads are in great shape!

As of now we are still operating in "summer" mode with everything being managed as there is not enough snow to alter management or openings/closures of areas.

A \$5 day-use fee or 2016/2017 annual parking pass is required at most trailheads throughout the park
