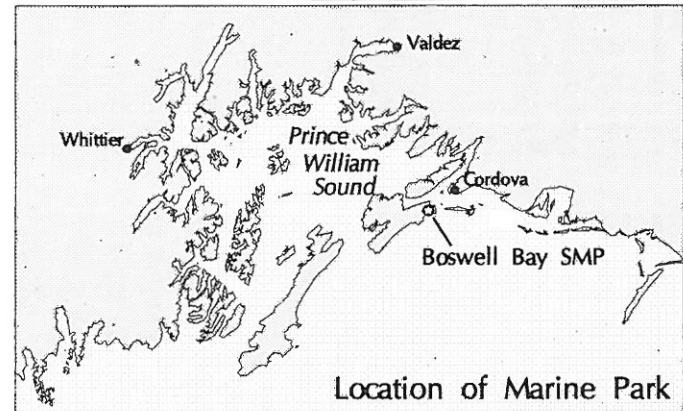

# Boswell Bay State Marine Park

Boswell Bay State Marine Park is located on the eastern tip of Hinchinbrook Island approximately 15 miles southwest of Cordova. This park primarily encompasses outer gulf coast beaches. A substantial part of the park upland was created by land uplift during the 1964 earthquake. This uplifted land is state owned but state ownership not shown because of indefinite boundaries. The Forest Service currently manages these lands.

Approximate acreage of the marine park: 2,980 acres.
