**City of Snow Bunting, Alaska
Resolution # 16-08**

**Authorize the City to Submit to the State of Alaska
a Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant Application
to Assist with Improvements at Polar Bear Park**

WHEREAS the State of Alaska, Department of Natural Resources, Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreation administers the federal grant program titled the Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF);

WHEREAS the grant provides 50% matching funds for public outdoor recreation projects;

WHEREAS Polar Bear Park is a popular 10-acre area along the bluff of Snow Bunting previously designated for public outdoor recreation use and is in need of upgrades;

WHEREAS the City is a qualified applicant for LWCF grant assistance, and Polar Bear Park has been identified in the City's Master Plan as a high priority for needed upgrades;


WHEREAS the City of Snow Bunting proposes to use \$75,000 in LWCF grant funds to assist with upgrades in Polar Bear Park;

WHEREAS the City intends to use local funds, donations, and a Lions Club grant as match;


WHEREAS the City commits to maintaining improvements made to Polar Bear Park and to maintain the site in perpetuity for public outdoor recreation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Snow Bunting supports and approves the City's preparation and submission of a Land and Water Conservation Fund grant application to assist with funding improvements at Polar Bear Park;
