## Portions of Chugach State Park closed to due to McHugh Creek fire

(Anchorage, AK) – Due to the ongoing response to the McHugh Creek fire, state park officials have closed Chugach State Park trails and adjacent park lands to public use between the Potter Creek and Rainbow trailheads (inside the pink boundary line shown on the image below), including all of the McHugh Creek and Rainbow Creek drainages. Closures specifically include the Turnagain Arm Trail between Potter and Rainbow, the McHugh Creek Trail, and the Rainbow Peak Trail as well as the McHugh Creek wayside, Beluga Point pullout and Rainbow trailhead.
