*Please note: Upper Tikchik Lakes and Tikchik River Camping and Floating Permits are limited. Permits are available on a first-come first-served basis. A non-refundable \$100 permit fee is required of successful applicants to ensure a permit.*

**PARK USE PERMIT STIPULATIONS UPPER LAKES/TIKCHIK RIVER WOOD-TIKCHIK STATE PARK**

*(Be familiar with all stipulations)*

- 1. Non-assignment:** This permit may not be assigned without the written approval and acceptance of the assignee by the director or his/her designee. Further, the licensee shall not sublet or enter into any third party agreements involving the privileges authorized by this permit.
- 2. Non-waiver Provision:** The failure to enforce provision of this permit or any default on the part of the permittee in observance or performance of any of the conditions or requirements of this permit is not a waiver of the forfeiture provision or any other provision of the permit.
- 3. Permanent Structures:** Permanent structures are prohibited from being placed by the permittee on state park lands or waters.
- 4. Forfeiture:** Permittee shall forfeit the permit if he/she defaults in the performance or observance of any of the permit terms, covenants or stipulations or of a statute/regulation.
- 5. State Held Harmless:** The permittee agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the State of Alaska from any and all liability claims arising from the actions of the permittee or his/her agents, employees or clients while conducting activities under this permit on state park lands/waters.
- 6. Valid Claims and Applicable Laws:** This permit is subject to all valid claims and applicable laws and regulations.
- 7. Protection of Park Land or Property from Damage:** Permittee shall exercise diligence in protecting from damage the land, property and resources of the State of Alaska in the area covered by and used in connection with this permit and shall pay the state for any damage resulting from negligence or from the violation of the terms of this permit or any law or regulation applicable to the use of state parks by the permittee.
- 8. Geographic Limitation:** This permit is applicable only for the use areas described.
- 9. No Preferential Right of Renewal:** No rights of renewal or preferential rights for renewal are attached to this permit.
- 10. Natural Hazards:** The permittee recognizes and understands that natural hazards are likely to exist within the area of his/her operation and agrees to take all reasonable precautions to make him/her aware of these hazards and to avoid injury to persons or property.
- 11. State Inspection of Permit Area:** The state reserves the right to inspect areas of activity under this permit. It is understood, however, that the state will only inspect the site during normal periods of activity by the permittee or at other times that are convenient to the permittee unless in an emergency situation.
- 12. Firearms:** Firearms carried will be the direct responsibility of the permittee. Misuse of firearms in violation of state or federal laws or regulations, may result in termination of this permit. The use and discharge of a weapon for the purpose of lawful hunting or trapping is allowed. No target shooting – site your firearms prior to the trip.
- 13. Camp Cleanliness:** The permittee agrees to take adequate precautions around camp to guard against human/bear encounters. The camp will be kept clean, no food will be kept in tents, and food will be cached away from the camp.
- 14. Trash and Garbage Removal:** All trash and garbage will be carried out of the park unit. No trash or garbage will be burned.
- 15. Campfires:** Campfires are allowed only on gravel bars and beaches.
- 16. Group Size:** Group size is not to exceed 10 persons.
- 17. Firewood:** No cutting of green vegetation. The gathering of firewood is limited to dead and down material.
- 18. Water:** The State of Alaska recommends that persons treat or boil all water that is used for drinking or cooking.
- 19. Generators:** Use of generators is prohibited.
- 20. Sanitation:** The permittee agrees to dispose of human waste at least 200 feet from surface water. Toilet paper will be burned or packed out and waste covered with topsoil or contained and removed to an approved disposal facility. Dumping of human waste in park waters is not allowed.
- 21. Litter Removal:** Permittee shall remove all litter caused by their activities and shall make a reasonable effort to pick up and remove from the park litter which they find in the vicinity of their activities within the park.
- 22. Chikuminuk Lake:** The use of a motorized boat is prohibited on Chikuminuk Lake.
- 23. Permit Fee:** A permit fee of \$100.00 must be paid prior to approval of the permit.

Permits are issued in accordance with 11 AAC 18.010. I have read and understand and agree to comply with permit stipulations #1 through #23. Non-compliance with the stipulations may result in a citation being issued and permit suspension or revocation.
