User Guide

Alaska Mapper Lite's primary purpose is to provide a quick and easy way to get maps and land records information. The functionality has been limited so as to speed up processing time. To run queries, download information or print a map, please go to the [full version](#).

Click here to return to Map selection

Click here to open the Navigate tool.

Use arrows to pan in any direction. Center button returns the map to its original extent.

Use the zoom bar or your mouse wheel to zoom in and out on an area of the map.

Zoom into an area by holding the shift key and clicking on the map to draw a box around an area.

Click once, anywhere on the map to view information about a location. Navigate through the data using the blue arrow buttons.

Click the small triangle to the left of the layer name to view a layer's graphic representation. Toggle on and off the layer visibility (V) and Labels (L) all at once, or individually, using the check box columns. Click on the underlined heading to link to ASGDC information page.
