ITEM SALE PROCEDURE

1. All items will be sold by sealed bid.
2. All items will be offered with a minimum bid amount specified paid by Cashier's check made payable to the State of Alaska or cash.
3. All bids must be received by the published deadline.
4. All bids must be in a sealed envelope, marked "Mat-Maid Sale" with the date and number of the sale item on the outside. Bid form must be included, signed, dated and have a current address and contact number.
5. A sales committee will review all sealed bids.
6. Bids below minimum will be rejected.
7. No conditional bids will be accepted.
8. If two or more bids are for identical amounts, the bid openers will determine by a flip of a coin which bid is placed first on the list.
9. The high bidder, upon notification, will have 10 business days to pay in full and remove purchases.
10. If the item high bidder does not make the purchase by 10 business days after notification, the next highest bidder will be offered to purchase at next bid price until the item is sold. If the item does not sell it will be reevaluated and offered again at a later date.
11. Bids to be paid by Cashier's check made payable to the State of Alaska or cash only.
12. All bids meeting the minimum requirement will be published on the Division of Agriculture website within 10 days of bid opening.
13. All sales will be "as is".
