

Local Foods, Local Places *Producer's Session*

TUESDAY, JULY 26 6:30 - 8 PM

WHO: Farmers and producers interested in working toward strengthening Palmer's local food system. Your participation and knowledge of Palmer and the region will be instrumental in this planning process!

WHAT: Part of a two-day planning workshop (see "Background" below), this short evening session focuses on the opportunities and challenges faced by Palmer-area farmers and growers. We are also seeking your viewpoint and innovative ideas that might bolster the local food system. Recognizing the limits on producer's time during the growing season, this special session is designed to rapidly engage producers about how the project goals can best support them. Your feedback and ideas will be shared with all workshop attendees and will help guide the selection and prioritization of actions.

BACKGROUND: In 2015, our community submitted an application for technical assistance from the federal Local Foods, Local Places initiative. Palmer was among 27 communities selected from among 340 applicants to receive assistance. The two-day workshop is a participatory planning process on local foods and community livability for Downtown Palmer and the Greater Palmer area.
