Alaska Flour Company is the only commercial flourmill in Alaska. The primary reason for starting the flourmill was to increase Alaska's food security.



Our flour is 100% whole grain flour – nothing removed and nothing added.



Barley is an ideal crop for Alaska because of its short growing season. It can be grown without irrigation and is higher in protein than barley grown in the lower 48.



Barley is the oldest known grain. In many parts of the world it is the primary grain for human consumption.



Barley flour doesn't require a special recipe. You can use your favorite recipes and substitute barley flour for 100% of the flour in most recipes unless making raised breads.



Our farm is over 1700 acres. We grow wheat, barley, hullless barley, and field peas.
