Rinse and remove visible mud & plant debris from rods, nets, waders, anchors, boats, and other gear.



DRAIN Empty coolers, bilge pumps, buckets, and wring out gear before leaving.



DRY Completely dry equipment and gear between visits to different water bodies.

Never release plants, fish, or other animals in water unless they are native to that waterbody. This includes BAIT!
