



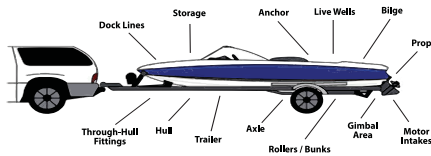
ATTENTION BOATERS!

Non-native plants and animals can clog waterways, impede boating and fishing, displace native species, and cause economic hardship!

Before launching and before leaving...
Inspect everything!



CLEAN

Rinse and remove visible mud & plant debris from boats, trailers and gear.



DRAIN

Empty coolers, bilge pumps, buckets, and wring out gear before leaving.



DRY

Completely dry equipment and gear between visits to different water bodies.

Never release plants, fish, or other animals in water unless they are native to that waterbody. This includes BAIT!
