Subject to AS 03.10.050 and regulations implementing this law, the Board of Agriculture and Conservation (BAC) by and through the Division of Agriculture is offering for sale by Competitive Sealed Bid, the former Matanuska Maid Bottle Manufacturing Facility in Palmer, Alaska. The sale includes the real property and improvements. The property being offered is:

ASLS 96-004, Tract A-1 recorded 08/06/1999 as Plat Number 99-62 in the Palmer Recording District; and further identified as Matanuska Susitna Borough Tax Parcel # 4871000T00A-1 located at 513 South Valley Way, Palmer Alaska.

The minimum acceptable offer for the property being offered is \$975,000.00. The method, terms and conditions of disposal and requirements of bidders are stated in the ARLF Sale #09-01 Brochure.
