DNR seeks applicants for Farm to School mini-grants

(Fairbanks, AK) – The Division of Agriculture is now seeking applications for its annual Farm to School mini-grant. The application period ends at 5 p.m. on Wednesday, May 15.

Mini-grants are available for school-based projects that connect students, teachers, or school food service staff with products grown and produced in Alaska. Between \$500 and \$3,000 in state funds will be allocated per project.
