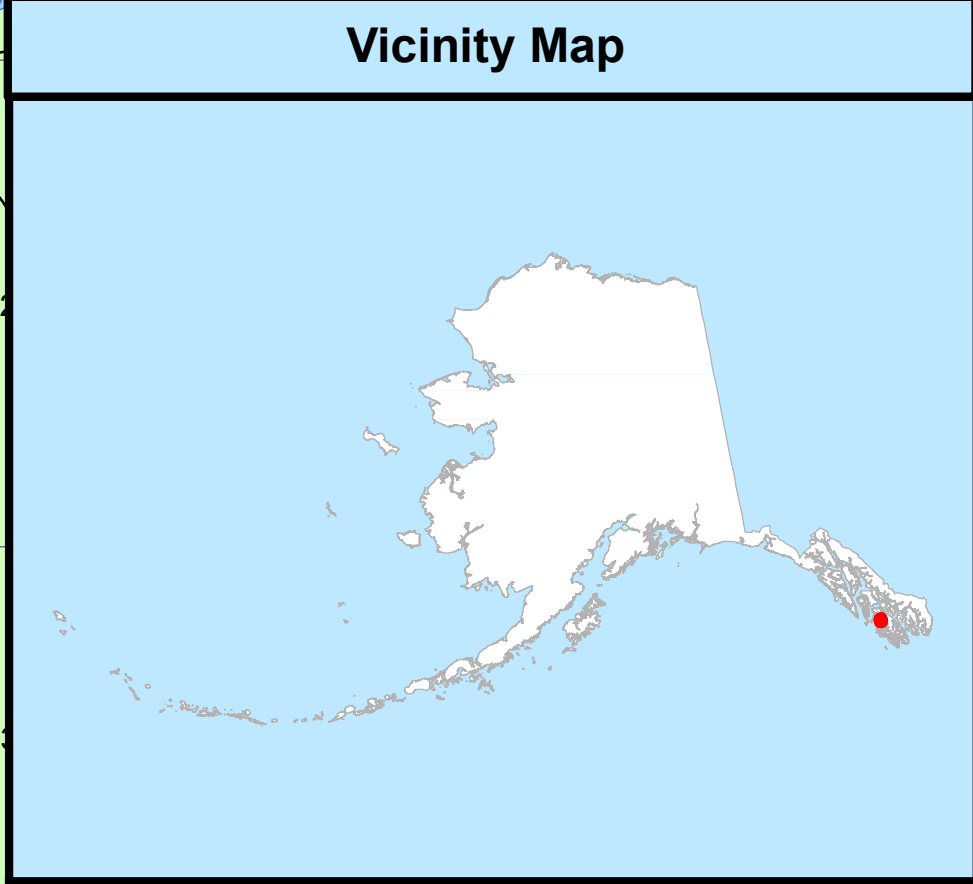


Sealaska Land Entitlement Finalization

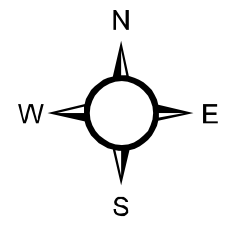
