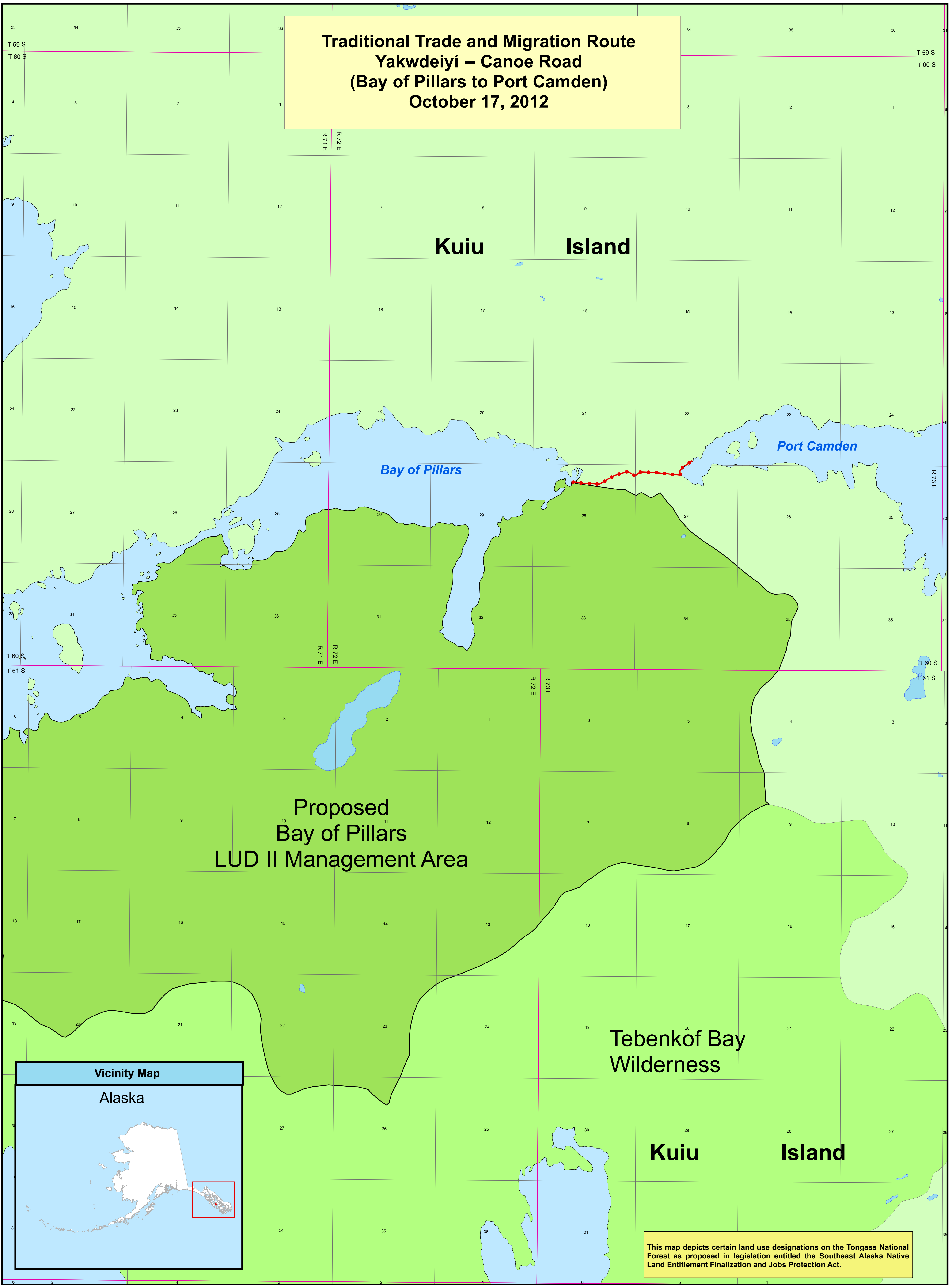


**Traditional Trade and Migration Route

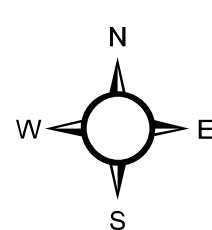
