The State of Alaska resource agencies thank Mr. Derril Bergt of FAA for scheduling the teleconference held this morning to review concerns expressed in the State's letter (dated March 18, 1996) regarding the above-referenced proposal. In attendance were Mr. Bergt, Lieutenant Colonel Siter of the U.S. Air Force, Dan Reed of Alaska Department of Fish and Game, and myself.

The State believes that the Air Force and FAA have done everything possible within the parameters of Air Force training requirements to lessen potential impacts to wildlife. The State therefore agrees that an acceptable resolution of issues has been reached, and does not object to the proposed TMOAs referenced above.

The State resource agencies appreciate the continuing dialogue with FAA and the Air Force, and look forward to working together to minimize air safety hazards and potential adverse impacts to wildlife, subsistence, and recreational activities associated with future training exercises.
