## Alaskans Can Now Bid on 209 Parcels in State Land Auction

(Anchorage, AK) – The Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is inviting Alaskans interested in owning a piece of the Last Frontier to participate in the 2023 Alaska State Land Auction offering #495, which includes a mix of 209 road-accessible or remote parcels throughout the state.

"Land auctions are just one of the ways DNR helps implement my administration's vision of putting Alaska land into Alaskans' hands, and I encourage everyone to consider taking advantage of this opportunity."

Alaska residents may submit sealed bids online, in person, or by mail through Oct. 3 at 4:30 p.m. Apparent high bids will be announced Oct. 24. Bidders may win and purchase up to two parcels.
