

State Land Ownership: Alaska Department of Natural Resources (ADNR), Land Administration System (section-level resolution), April 2010.

State Legislative Designated Areas: ADNR, Land Administration System (section-level resolution), August 2010.

ANCSA: Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act, Bureau of Land Management (section-level resolution), April 2010.

Other Municipal and Private Lands: Patented Deposited Federal Lands (Private Parcels), Bureau of Land Management (section-level resolution), April 2010 and ADNR, Land Administration System (section-level resolution), April 2010.

Native Allotments: Patented/Conveyed Spatial data; Bureau of Land Management (ADNR), Spatial Data Management System (data as of April 2010, August 2010).

Federal Lands: Bureau of Land Management (ALIS, Alaska Land Information System, August 2010).

Conservation System Units: Bureau of Land Management (1991) and ADNR data (February 1996).

Military Lands: Bureau of Land Management (section-level resolution), April 2010.

Geographic Place Names: Dictionary of Alaska Place Names (1967) and U.S. Geological Survey (Quadrangle Maps, 1:1 million scale, annotated by U.S. Geological Survey, 1996, and annotated by ADNR, June 1996).

Borough Boundaries: ADNR (approximately 1:1 million scale, annotated from U.S. Census Bureau data (1990, verified and updated by ANCSA and ADNR, December 2007)).

The Alaska Marine Mammal Refuge (AMMR) is not completely accurate. Areas which are depicted are either reserves, they are not defined. The Alaska Marine MMR is described as follows:

The Alaska Marine MMR consists of all public lands, including submerged lands and waters, rivers, streams, bays, gulfs, straits, and other bodies of water, and the lands and waters adjacent to and within the boundaries of the Alaska Marine MMR. The Alaska Marine MMR is defined as the area bounded by the Gulf of Alaska, the Bering Sea, the Chukchi Sea, the Bering Sea, the Gulf of Alaska, and the Bering Sea, and includes an undetermined quantity of submerged lands, and other lands, the status of which is generally determined by the U.S. Coast and Geodetic Survey, Alaska Marine MMR (October 1978).

Note: This map shows general land ownership information. When reviewing this map, please remember that federal, ANCSA, and state land ownership is determined hierarchically by statute. For example, any portion of a section (and associated public use areas) that is tentatively approved land cannot be the subject of a state claim, even if the state has patented or tentatively approved land in only a portion of the section, and federal land and ANCSA land also occur in the section.

The land ownership hierarchy is as follows:

- State Municipal Entities or Land Exchanges or Other Land Disposals.
- Patented Deposited Federal Lands (Native Allotments or Private Parcels).
- State Patented or Tentatively Approved or Other State Acquired Lands (includes easements 101-114, 116-117, 128-129).
- Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act (ANCSA) Patented or Interim Conveyed.
- Major Military.
- National Wildlife Refuges, National Park System Units.
- National Wild & Scenic Rivers outside National Park System Units and National Wildlife Refuges.
- National Forests and Monuments, National Petroleum Reserve, Alaska, National Recreation Areas and National Conservation Areas.
- Bureau of Land Management Public Lands.
