User Guide

Alaska Mapper Lite's primary purpose is to provide a quick and easy way to get maps and land records information. The functionality has been limited so as to speed up processing time. The application is approved to run in MS Internet Explorer (Edge), Mozilla Firefox and Google Chrome. Also it is recommended to run the application in a maximized window for best results.

Zoom-In, Zoom-Out and Full-Extent buttons.

Return to homepage.

Click the small triangle to the left of the layer name to view a layer's symbology. Toggle on and off the layer visibility (V) and Labels (L) all at once, or individually, using the check box columns. Click on the layer name for metadata about the layer.

Zoom into an area by holding the shift key and clicking on the map to draw a box around an area.

Click once, anywhere on the map to view information about a location. Navigate through the data using the blue arrow buttons.

Scale/distance in feet or miles depending on zoom.

Center township information menu.

Across the top portion of window:
Zoom-In, Zoom-Out and Full Extent buttons.

Navigation button and Map Options menu.

Mouse latitude/longitude coordinates.
