The Division of Coastal and Ocean Management (DCOM) has been coordinating the State's review of your proposed project for consistency with the Alaska Coastal Management Program (ACMP).


On January 18, 2008 DCOM finished consultation with participating State agencies and decided to further extend the ACMP consistency schedule 17 calendar days. This decision was made because the British Columbia permitting process is generating information that the State agencies believe the Alaska public and State agencies should also include in their review, therefore DCOM has again rescheduled the Public Meeting and extended the State's comment period.

Under the revised review schedule deadlines the relevant dates are as follows:

- Public Meeting - 2/4/08
- Request for Additional Information - 2/14/08
- Consistency Comments Due - 2/21/08
- Proposed ACMP Consistency Determination - 3/2/08
- Final ACMP Consistency Determination - 3/7/08
