**RECORDABLE DISCLAIMER OF INTEREST**

*WHEREAS*, the State of Alaska is entitled to a recordable disclaimer of interest pursuant to Section 315(a) of the Federal Land Policy and Management Act of October 21, 1976, 43 U.S.C. 1745(a), the United States of America, acting by and through the Bureau of Land Management – Alaska State Director, hereby gives notice that the United States claims no real property interest in the lands underlying the water body comprising the Muddy River, Lake Minchumina, and the Kantishna River, and therefore disclaims any and all real property interest in the submerged lands more particularly described as:

1. Muddy River (FF-94610) between the ordinary high water lines of the left and right banks, beginning from its outlet at Lake Minchumina within Township 12 South, Range 23 West, Fairbanks Meridian, downstream to the confluence with Birch Creek in Township 12 South, Range 21 West, Fairbanks Meridian, Alaska;
2. Lake Minchumina (FF-94611) the submerged lands encompassed by the ordinary high water line of Lake Minchumina within Township 11 South, Range 24 West, and Township 12 South, Ranges 23 to 25 West, Fairbanks Meridian, Alaska;
3. Kantishna River (FF-94612) all submerged lands lying within the bed of the Kantishna River, between the ordinary high water lines of the left and right banks, beginning at the abandoned site of Roosevelt (Section 32, Township 11 South, Range 19 West, Fairbanks Meridian) downstream to its confluence with the Tanana River in Township 2 South, Range 12 West, Fairbanks Meridian, Alaska.

This disclaimer is subject to all valid existing rights, if any.


