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**ADL:** An easement granted or retained by the Alaska Division of Land.

**ANCSA:** Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act

**AJV:** Afognak Joint Venture

**AKI:** Akhiok-Kaguyak, Inc.

**ANC:** Afognak Naive Corporation

**AYA:** Ayakulik, Inc.

**BLM:** Bureau of land Management

**CHA:** Critical Habitat Area

**DNR:** Department of Natural Resources

**EIN:** A public access easement established under section 17(b) of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act. Uses allowed on an EIN easement are listed in the easement section.

**FAA:** Federal Aviation Administration

**FAS:** A road that was conveyed to the State of Alaska by the quit claim deed dated June 3, 1959, executed under the authority of the Alaska Omnibus Act.

**FD:** An easement dedicated by a deed filed with the State Recorder's office.

**FP:** An easement dedicated by a plat filed with the State Recorder's office.

**KIB:** Kodiak Island Borough

**KIC:** Karluk IRA Council

**KON:** Koniag, Inc.

**LAS:** An easement retained by the federal government in a native allotment conveyance.

**LES:** Leisnoi, Inc.

**LSH:** An easement granted to the State of Alaska by a private property owner.

**NOK:** Natives of Kodiak, Inc.

**NP:** National Park

**NWR:** national Wildlife Refuge

**OLD:** Old harbor Native Corporation

**OUZ:** Ouzinkie Native Corporation
