GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

This form should *only* be used for mining claims or mining leasehold locations that are located under Title 38 of the Alaska Statutes on land under the jurisdiction of the State of Alaska. This form may also be used as a LOCATION NOTICE to be posted on the northeast corner monument (corner #1). Please note that locations on land selected by, but not yet conveyed to the State are made at the locator's own risk. AS 38.05.275, 11 AAC 86.115(a). For information about mineral locations under federal mining law, please contact the Federal Bureau of Land Management.

POSTING THE LOCATION NOTICE

When this form is used as a *LOCATION NOTICE* on the northeast corner monument, it *must* contain a sketch map of the claims being converted, which depicts to the best of your knowledge the location of the new MTRSC claim in relation to the converted claims and any other surrounding mineral locations. The LOCATION NOTICE must be posted on monument #1 located at the northeast corner of the claim. The following information is *required* on the LOCATION NOTICE CERTIFICATE: Meridian, Township, Range, Section, Quarter Section, and if applicable, Quarter-Quarter Section, and the name of the recording district in which the claim is located.

A locator converting existing mining claims to an MTRSC claim shall in good faith mark the corners of a the new MTRSC location as closely as practical to the existing quarter section or quarter-quarter section of the rectangular survey system approved by the commissioner; the corners marked on the ground of a claim established in accordance with this paragraph and regulations of the commissioner control in the event of a conflict over boundaries for the quarter section or quarter-quarter section of the protracted or actual survey approved by the commissioner;..."

RECORDING THE CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

If mailing to the recorder's office, check with the office beforehand so you can submit the correct fee. The recording fees change from time to time. You may also check on recording fees through the internet at the following site address: *www.dnr.state.ak.us/ssd/recoff/fees.htm.* The recorder's office will forward copies of all recorded mining documents to the Alaska Department of Natural Resources, Division of Mining, Land & Water.

Failure to properly complete either the location notice or certificate may constitute abandonment of the mining claim. AS 38.05.265. Failure to timely record the location certificate with the proper district recorder's office constitutes abandonment of the mining claim. AS 38.05.265. Failure to timely make this annual rental payment constitutes abandonment of the mining location under AS 38.05.265.

ANNUAL RENTAL PAYMENT

Conversion of traditional claims to an MTRSC location is not complete unless the annual rental due on the traditional locations for the year in which conversion occurs is timely paid in full. *Failure to timely make an annual rental payment on the traditional claims constitutes abandonment of both the traditional claims and the proposed converted MTRSC claim.* AS 38.05.265.

The annual rental paid on the traditional claims in the year of conversion will be credited toward the first annual rental due on the converted new MTRSC claim. The rental amount due on the new claim will be calculated based on the size of the claim and the average rental age of the existing traditional claims at the time of conversion. A one-time 50% discount will be applied to the rental year following the year of conversion. For a more detailed description of how the monies are calculated and applied, see 11 AAC 86.260 and 11 AAC 86.265.
