


TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 59 EAST, OF THE COPPER RIVER MERIDIAN, ALASKA




A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat and field notes represent the survey of a portion of the south boundary, and a portion of the subdivisional lines of section 36 of Township 39 South, Range 59 East, of the Copper River Meridian, Alaska.

This survey was executed by Gary L. McIntyre, Cadastral Surveyor, November 6 through December 10, 2004, in accordance with the specifications set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1973, and Special Instructions for Group No. 941, Alaska, dated October 22, 2004.


The direction of all lines returned on this plat are reported as mean bearings with reference to the true meridian.




Mean Magnetic Declination 23 1/4° E.
