

**SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE REGARDING  
PROPOSED CHANGES IN THE  
REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES**

This is a supplement to the public notice issued on October 14, 2011 by the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) regarding its proposal to adopt regulation changes in Title 11 of the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC), specifically 11 AAC 96.014(b)(3) and (20) dealing with the Special Use Land, Hatcher Pass and Exit Glacier Road Special Use Areas. The Department of Natural Resources also proposes to adopt new regulations in Title 11, of the Alaska Administrative Code, specifically 11 AAC 96.014(b)(26) dealing with Special Use Land, Kasilof River Special Use Area.

**EXTENSION OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD**

DNR has received requests for additional time to review and comment on these proposed regulations. The original comment deadline was 5:00 p.m., Friday November 18, 2011. In order to address these requests, DNR has extended the public comment deadline for 14 days. The comments must now be received by the department no later than **5:00 p.m. on Friday, on December 2, 2011**. No changes have been made to the proposed regulations.
