The Southcentral Regional Land Office will be temporarily allowing the taking of pre-cut timber on the **west side** of the site easement known as the Maud Road Rifle Range, ADL 230693, on the Maud Road Extension within the Knik River Public Use Area (KRPUA), for the purpose of public firewood consumption from **April 29th, 2014 through May 8th, 2014**. No commercial vendors or vehicles will be allowed. After this date, no retrieval of wood will be allowed until the project is complete.

Free permits can be issued online at <https://dnr.alaska.gov/FPS/> or in person at 101 Airport Road, Palmer, AK 99645. By state law, you must have a permit to retrieve firewood.

The site is located approximately 3 miles down the Maud Road Extension within Section 16, Township 17 North, Range 3 East, Seward Meridian. It can also be found by GPS at grid 61.562775°, -148.931362°.

During this time, there will be **no public access will be allowed on the construction site itself**. The site will have multiple pieces of heavy equipment maneuvering on site and sometimes including Maud Road. Workers will also be working downrange of the road along and including the tree line and berms.
