Revised Public Notice

ADL 230693 – Site Easement
(USGS 1:63,360 Quad Map Anchorage C-6)
(SW1/4 NW1/4 Section 16, Township 17 North, Range 3 East, Seward Meridian)

This is a dual public notice that has been revised from the original notice (published on 4/3/2009) due to technical errors.

Subject to AS 38, the Southcentral Regional Land Office will be establishing a Site Easement on the Maud Road Extension within the Knik River Public Use Area for the purpose of developing a small scale rifle range. The public is invited to comment on this action. The Site Easement and associated rifle range development will be located in an area identified for this activity as outlined in the Knik River Public Use Area Management Plan, which went into effect and was approved by the Commissioner of the Department of Natural Resources on September 25, 2008.

The proposed project is also being reviewed for consistency with the Alaska Coastal Management Program (ACMP) and the Matanuska Susitna Coastal Management Program. The Division of Mining, Land and Water must receive written comments regarding review of the Site Easement under AS 38 before 5:00 PM, May 6, 2009. The comment period pertaining to consistency with ACMP has been extended to May 6, 2009 (per 11 AAC 110.270 (a)(1)) to coincide with the comment deadline for the Site Easement comment period. Comments about inconsistency with ACMP must identify the relevant enforceable policy and explain how the project is not consistent with that policy. A copy of the ACMP review packet is available for public inspection by contacting David Griffin. If public comments in response to this notice result in significant changes to the issuance of this easement, further notice will be given. If there are no significant changes, the easement becomes final without further notice. The final decision will be available at a later date.
