The Department of Natural Resources is offering Alaskans an opportunity to stake and purchase state land in one of 5 different remote locations in Southcentral and Northern Alaska.

A lottery drawing will be held to award 225 staking authorizations in the following staking areas: Aniak-Doestock, Kakhonak Lake, Albert Creek North, Zitziana and Teklanika III. Applicants need not be present to win.

State Land Offering
2012 Remote Recreational Cabin Sites Offering #11
Lottery Application Period Begins March 12, 2012

In accordance with Alaska Statute (AS) 38.05.945 and AS 38.05.057 (e), the Department of Natural Resources is pleased to announce a competitive disposal of State-owned land after final decision issued under AS 38.05.035 (e).

Alaska residents may apply for an authorization to stake a parcel of State-owned land in a designated Remote Recreational Cabin Sites staking area and purchase the land at market value per AS 38.05.600.

A total of 225 staking authorizations will be awarded in the Northern and Southcentral Regions. The Northern Region staking areas are Albert Creek North, Zitziana, and Teklanika III. The Southcentral Region staking areas are Aniak-Doestock and Kakhonak Lake.

A land sales brochure will be available Wednesday, March 7, 2012 at locations around the state, Department Public Information Centers, and online at:

The staking authorization application period begins Monday, March 12, 2012. The Department of Natural Resources must receive applications by 5:00 pm on Thursday, April 26, 2012. Applications received after this time will not be accepted.

Application forms are available in land sale brochures or online and may be mailed or submitted in person. Applications may also be submitted online.

A lottery drawing will be held if the number of applications exceeds the available authorizations for an area. Authorizations for staking areas not requiring a lottery will be awarded at the end of the lottery.

The lottery drawing will be held at 10:00 am on Friday, May 11, 2012 in Anchorage at 550 W 7th Avenue, Suite 1260 in Anchorage. You do not need to be present to win.
