EXTENSION OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD
WISHBONE HILL COAL EXPLORATION PERMIT RENEWAL

The Department of Natural Resources has extended the public comment period for the renewal of the Wishbone Exploration Permit. The deadline to submit written comment closes at 5:00PM on Wednesday, June 2, 2010.

Usibelli Coal Mine Inc. (UCM), P.O. Box 1000, Healy, AK 99743 has filed for a renewal of their Wishbone Hill Coal Exploration Permit No. 01-86-795. This would renew the existing permit for two additional years.

The exploration activity is located in the Wishbone Hill area, approximately 8 miles east of Palmer, Alaska. The proposed exploration activities will be within: Township 19 North, Range 2 East (Seward Meridian), all of Sections 13, 24 and parts of sections 14, 22, 23, and 25-28; and Township 19 North, Range 3 East (Seward Meridian), all of Sections 3, 7-1- and parts of section 2, 11, and 15-19.

Authorized exploration activities will consist of drilling up to 20 drill holes and the excavation of several shallow trenches. Several drill holes may be left as monitoring well locations. There will be a geologic surface mapping program, and the construction of 1.5 miles of access trail. All sites will be reclaimed and all drill holes will also be reclaimed unless converted to hydrologic monitoring wells. Otherwise, drill holes will be sealed immediately upon completion of work at the site.

Pursuant to 11 AAC 90.167(b) the Division has determined that the reclamation bond in the amount of \$39,293.00 is sufficient to cover the associated reclamation costs. Detailed bond calculations are in the permit application.

The application complies with the requirements of the Alaska Surface Coal Mining Control and Reclamation Act (AS 27.21 and 11 AAC 90).
