
The Division of Coastal and Ocean Management (DCOM) has been coordinating the State's review of your proposed project for consistency with the Alaska Coastal Management Program (ACMP).

Earlier today DCOM received your email message stating: "Redfern Resources is requesting a 15-day extension to its consistency review schedule in order to allow sufficient time to respond to the RFAI received from DNR OHMP. We understand that the public meeting presently set for January 8th will have to be rescheduled. We suggest a date of January 23rd or 24th for the public meeting."

This letter is to inform Redfern Resources that, per 11 AAC 110.270(a)(6), DCOM is officially agreeing to your written request to extend the consistency review schedule by 15 calendar days. The effect of this extension will move all review deadlines back at least 15 calendar days (refer to attached "Revised Project Data Sheet").
