### **Request for Reconsideration Procedures**

A person affected by this decision may request reconsideration, in accordance with 11 AAC 02. Any reconsideration request must be received in writing within 20 calendar days after the date of issuance of this decision, as defined in 11 AAC 02.040(c) and (d), and may be mailed or delivered to Daniel S. Sullivan, Commissioner, Department of Natural Resources, 550 W. 7th Avenue, Suite 1400, Anchorage, Alaska 99501; or faxed to 1-907-269-8918; or sent by electronic mail to [dnr.appeals@alaska.gov](mailto:dnr.appeals@alaska.gov).

If reconsideration is not requested within the time allowed, or the commissioner does not order reconsideration or takes no action within 30 calendar days after issuance of this decision, this decision goes into effect and is a final administrative order and decision of the department on the 31st day after issuance. Failure of the commissioner to act on a request for reconsideration is an automatic denial of the request for reconsideration. This decision may then be appealed to Superior Court within a further 30 days in accordance with the Alaska Rules of the Court, and to the extent permitted by applicable law.

An eligible person must first request reconsideration of this decision in accordance with 11 AAC 02 before appealing this decision to Superior Court. A copy of 11 AAC 02 may be obtained from any regional information office of the Department of Natural Resources.
