

RECORDABLE DISCLAIMER OF INTEREST

Serial No. F-94615

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska is entitled to a recordable disclaimer of interest pursuant to Section 315(a) of the Federal Land Policy and Management Act of October 21, 1976, 43 U.S.C. 1745(a), the United States of America, acting by and through the Bureau of Land Management – Alaska State Director, hereby gives notice that the United States claims no real property interest in the lands underlying the water body comprising the Chisana River, and therefore disclaims any and all real property interest in the submerged lands more particularly described as:

1. The Chisana River between the ordinary high water lines of the left and right banks, beginning from its mouth located in T. 15 N., R. 19 E., Copper River Meridian upstream to the confluence with Scottie Creek located in T. 11 N., R. 22 E., Copper River Meridian.
2. The “unnamed channel” between the ordinary high water lines of the left and right banks that interconnects the Chisana River and Mark Creek, located in T. 14 N., Rs. 19 and 20 E., Copper River Meridian.

This disclaimer is subject to all valid existing rights, if any.
