RECORDABLE DISCLAIMER OF INTEREST

Serial No. AA-086371

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska is entitled to a recordable disclaimer of interest pursuant to Section 315(a) of the Federal Land Policy and Management Act of October 21, 1976, 43 U.S.C. 1745(a), the United States of America, acting by and through the BLM – Alaska State Director, hereby gives notice that the United States claims no real property interest in the lands underlying the water body comprising the Kuskokwim River, and therefore disclaims any and all real property interest in the submerged lands more particularly described as:

The lands underlying the Kuskokwim River, excepting those lands within Public Land Order No. 255, 11 Fed. Reg. 8,368 (Aug. 2, 1946) (signed Dec. 15, 1944), from its beginning at the confluences of its North and South Forks, presently located in Township 28 South, Range 22 East, Kateel River Meridian, Alaska downstream approximately 540 miles to its confluence with the Kuskokwim Bay presently located within Township 2 South, Range 77 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska.

- a. Excepting therefrom the lands underlying the Kuskokwim River within Public Land Order No. 255, 11 Fed. Reg. 8,368 (Aug. 2, 1946) (signed Dec. 15, 1944), described as beginning at the point of intersection of Latitude 62 degrees 55 minutes N., with the center line of the deep water channel of the Kuskokwim River, approximate Longitude 155 degrees 33 minutes W. From the point of beginning: East, 2.25 miles; North, 3 miles; West, 1.12 miles, to the center line of the deep water channel of the Kuskokwim River; Southwesterly, 14.5 miles, downstream along center line of the deep water channel of the Kuskokwim River, to the point of beginning.

This disclaimer is subject to all valid existing rights, if any.
