WHEREAS, the State of Alaska is entitled to a recordable disclaimer of interest pursuant to Section 315(a) of the Federal Land Policy and Management Act of October 21, 1976, 43 U.S.C. 1745(a), the United States of America, acting by and through the Bureau of Land Management – Alaska State Director, hereby gives notice that the United States claims no real property interest in the lands underlying the water body comprising Scottie Creek, and therefore disclaims any and all real property interest in the submerged lands more particularly described as:

The lands underlying Scottie Creek, approximately 20 miles long between the ordinary high water mark on its banks, beginning at the west boundary of the sixty-foot-wide neutral strip at the United States-Canada International Boundary in Section 24, T. 10 N., R. 23 E., Copper River Meridian (CRM), downstream to its junction with the Chisana River within Section 3, T. 10 N., R. 22 E., and Section 34, T. 11 N., R. 22 E., CRM, Alaska.
