◆ RESERVED EASEMENTS:

EIN 1

An existing road running northeasterly from the diesel power plant. (60-foot road)

EIN 2a

An existing road running westerly from the diesel power plant. (60-foot road)

EIN 4-1

An existing trail running southeasterly from Ouzinkie to Sunny Cove. (25-foot trail)

EIN 4-2

An existing road running southerly from the diesel power plant to Rezanof Drive. 60-foot road)

EIN 8

A proposed trail from Anton Larsen Road at Red Cloud Creek southerly to Cope Mountain and then continuing westerly. (25-foot trail)

EIN 9a

An existing road running westerly from the diesel power plant. (60-foot road)

EIN 18-1

A proposed trail running northerly from Anton Larsen Road to the shore of Anton Larsen Bay at site EIN 18a. (25-foot trail)

EIN 18-2

An existing road on Woody Island running southerly from Icehouse Point.

EIN 18a

A campsite on the west shore of Anton Larsen Bay. (one-acre site)

EIN 20

An existing road along the shore of Spruce Cape. (60-foot road)

EIN 22

A proposed trail running westerly from Anton Larsen Road to the Three Pillar Point area. (25-foot trail)

EIN 22b

A campsite at the end of Anton Larsen Road. (one-acre site)

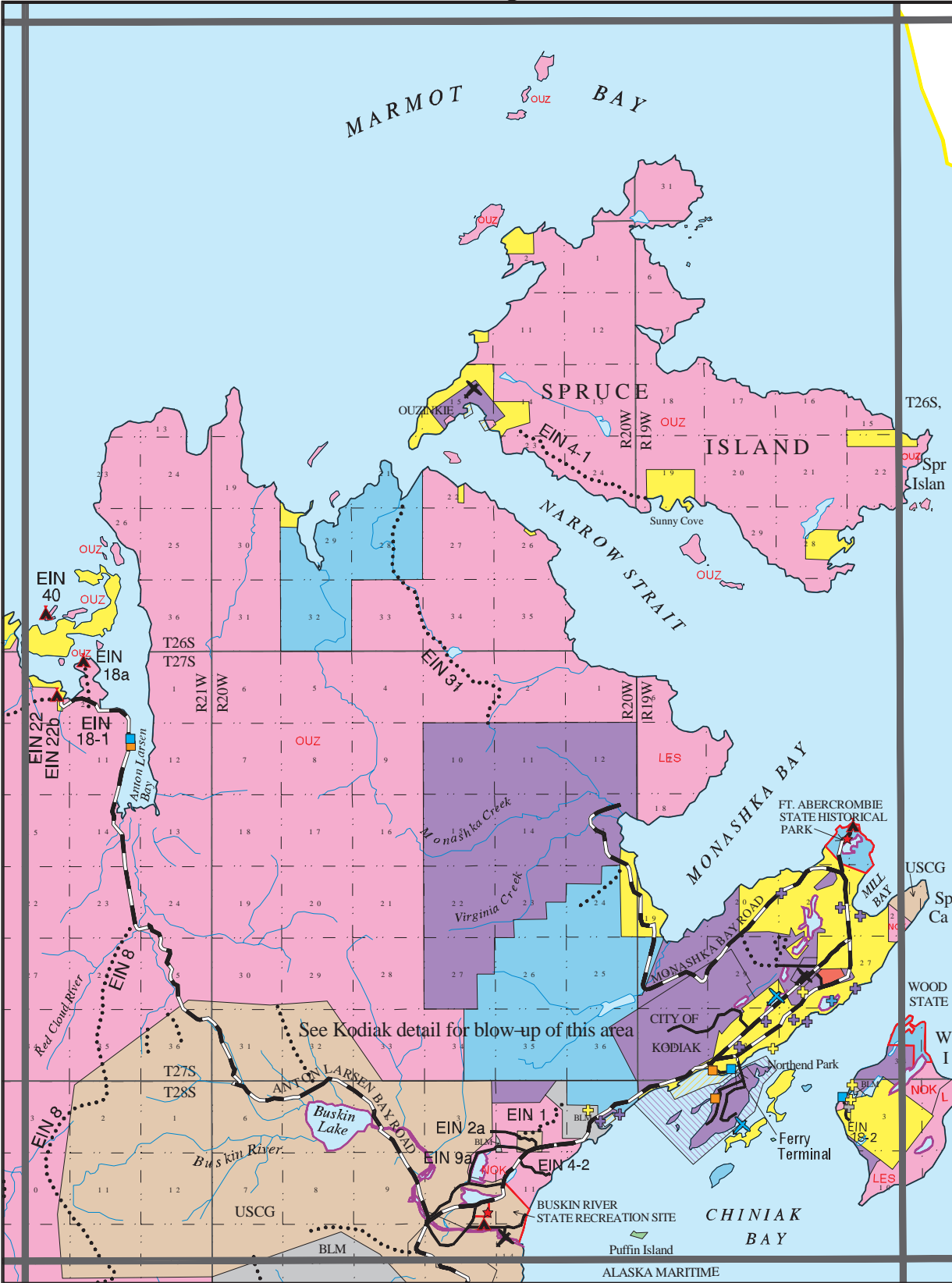
EIN 31

An existing trail beginning at Monashka Bay and running northwesterly to Neva Cove. (25-foot trail)

EIN 40d

A campsite on the south side an unnamed small island. (one-acre site)

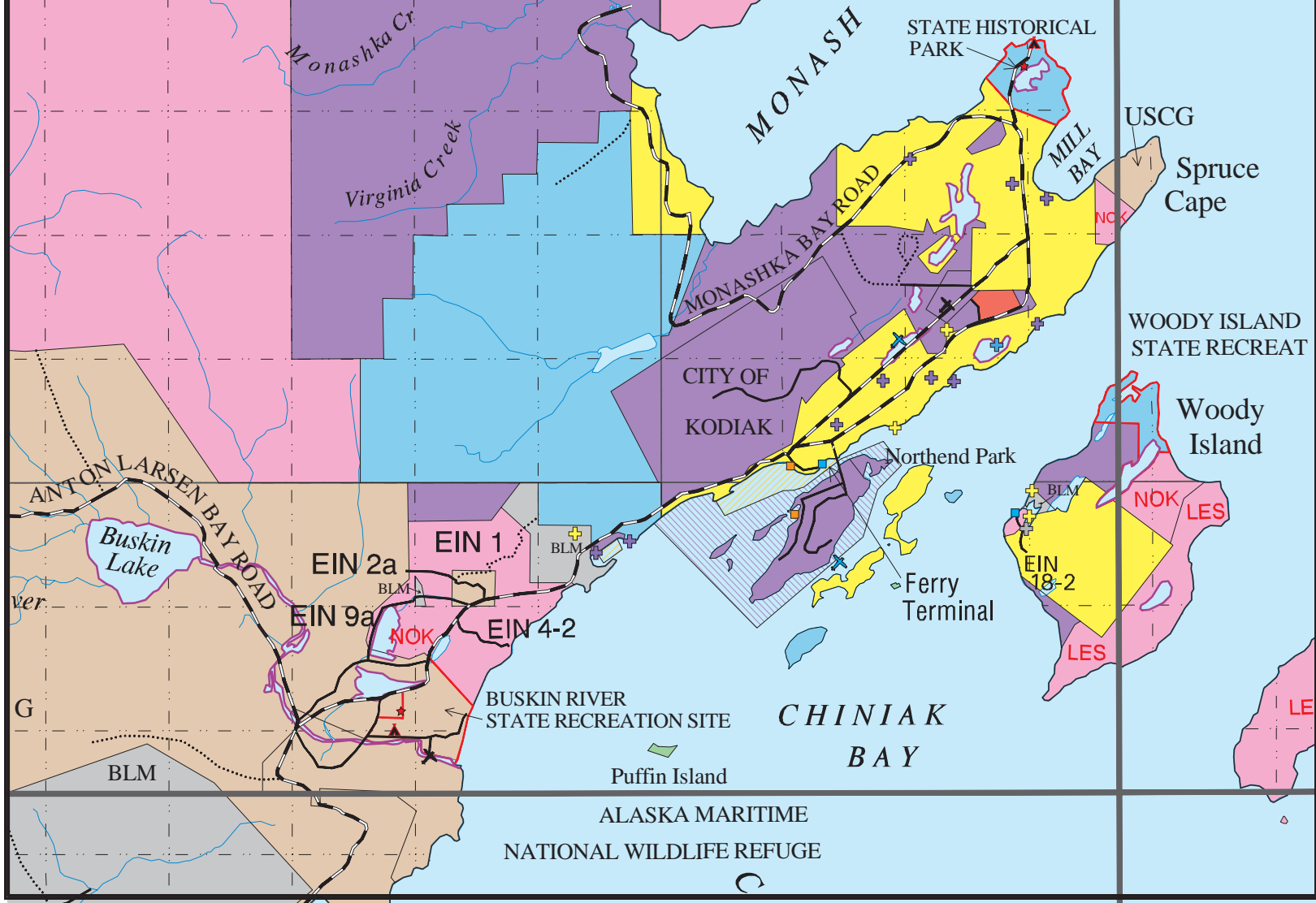
