

**AMENDMENT to ADDENDUM 'A' TO DOCUMENT OF INTENT (11/21/1986)
SPECIAL USE DESIGNATION
ADL 223585**

Addendum A to the Document of Intent (11/21/1986) is revised to add a new subsection.

V. Government Peak Subunit: Non-Motorized Area and Allowed Uses (p. 7)

1. The area of the Special Use Designation (ADL 223585) is revised to include the area of the Government Peak subunit (subunit) of the Hatcher Pass Management Plan (Management Plan), as depicted on the attached map (Map 2). All references in the Document of Intent and the Addendum to this subunit are to apply to this area.
2. The following requirements apply to state land and supersede all other requirements of the Document of Intent or Addendum that might apply to this subunit: a) the Government Peak subunit is designated a non-motorized area for non-commercial recreational uses except that snow-machines may operate in the Westside Mountains subarea and in designated areas or corridors, to be determined by the Department but consistent with the Borough Special Land Use Designation¹. b) Commercial recreational motorized uses shall adhere to the standards of Article II (Activities Covered by Special Use Area) in the Addendum and may only operate within designated corridors and trails, as determined by the Department but consistent with the Borough Special Land Use Designation. c) Except for emergency vehicles, all motorized uses shall be authorized by permit. d) Permits or other authorizations issued by the Department shall be consistent with the requirements of the Management Plan and the Borough Special Land Use Designation. All land uses that are identified in the Borough Special Land Use Designation as 'conditional' require authorization by permit and land uses that are identified as 'prohibited' are prohibited.
