


NORTH SLOPE MANAGEMENT PLAN



WHY HAVE A PLAN

- A comprehensive land use plan for the state lands in the area has never been developed
 - Planning until now has been on a site-specific basis
 - Has been primarily project driven (disposals)
- Planning is a way of sorting through the possibilities for using state land, determining those uses with the greatest benefits to all Alaskans, and involving the public in that process



- Recognize the statewide significance of the oil and gas resource in the area
- Increase permitting efficiency and predictability for the public, DNR and the oil & gas industry
- Facilitate municipal entitlement conveyance decisions to the North Slope Borough
- Identify important community use areas





WHAT THE PLAN DOES NOT DO:

- Address Oil and Gas Leasing, done through the Best Interest Finding process
- Address allocation, regulation or harvest of fish and wildlife stock (ADF&G function)
- Apply to private, borough, federal, or native corporation lands

WHAT HAS HAPPENED TO DATE

- Contracts issued for data collection
 - Infrastructure and habitat data
- Identifying and reviewing local plans
- Gaining an understanding of area land status/ownership patterns
- Identifying issues that affect the area
 - Gravel
 - Water

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT

- Engage communities during scoping process with additional meetings, updated meeting schedule
- Comment period extends until July 31st to allow plenty of time for public input
- After the comment period ends, public input is considered and used in the development of a draft plan
