CHAPTER 1 -- INTRODUCTION
Revision of Initial Plan

p. 1-3, lines 31-33, the sentence is to be modified to read:

"This will not preclude the BBCRSA from revising its District Management Plan or developing, if appropriate, additional 'local' standards for the Nushagak and Mulchatna River systems that lie within their jurisdiction, which does not include areas within the corporate limits of the Lake and Peninsula Borough".

CHAPTER 2 – GOALS, MANAGEMENT INTENT, AND GUIDELINES
Siting Criteria

p. 2-8, lines 10-13, section 15.1 is to be modified to read:

“15.1 Permanent facilities, temporary facilities, trapping and personal cabins, boat storage, airstrip development, docks, and other long-term uses (uses that take place at one site on state land for longer than 14 consecutive days) will be sited consistent with management intent and applicable guidelines. Consideration is to be given to the potential impacts to adjacent River Corridors prior to granting an authorization for a permanent facility. Adverse impacts are to be avoided or, failing that, minimized.”
