

Remote Recreational Cabin Site Area No. 1104102







- Note: The minimum parcel size within 1000 feet of the Teklanika River is 5 acres.
- All parcels staked on land owned by the State of Alaska that contain less than 50 feet of a surveyed or potential surveyed shoreline, are subject to a 50-foot wide easement on each side of the shoreline, which is reserved to the State of Alaska for public fisheries under ADL 10 00.0.0. Parcels may not be staked over a surveyed section line.
- Parcels may not be staked across any public or navigable water body. Parcels are subject to a 50-foot public access easement along the ordinary high water mark.
- Parcels are subject to a 100-foot building setback from the ordinary high water mark of all water bodies. State-wide setbacks may vary from staking activities to state drainage boundaries.
- A staking setback is required from unincorporated airports/airfields.
- A staking setback is required from airports used by the public.
- Most surveys (i.e. ADLS, USGS) have survey monuments at each corner, which may be used as reference points and corners when staking. Use the survey file for information on monument corner numbers, bearings, and distances. Monuments found in the Fairbanks quadrangle are the greater record.
- There are public access easements along most ADLS boundaries. Check the survey file for additional information.
- Tract boundaries have not been verified and their actual location may differ on the ground. Labeling of a tract boundary does not guarantee its existence of 4.741.
- Unincorporated villages are not maintained by the Department of Natural Resources. Use of maps on area land that are not supported is at your own risk.
- Staking map labels represent only selected coordinates for quick reference in locating staking area boundaries. There is no or may not be monuments at these locations.
- See the general staking instructions and site-specific supplemental staking instructions for additional information.
- Line drawings and aerial photographs associated with graphical explanations (ADL 10 00.0.0.04-0.5) are supplementary to or at the discretion of the DNR. - There is a 50-foot staking setback from the Denali - Kuskokwim Trail (RST 346).
