Video entries should support the *Kids Don't Float* objectives of educating Alaskans about the dangers of Alaska's cold water and the importance of always wearing a life jacket when boating. Create a video that is educational, meaningful, and reflects the *Kids Don't Float* message.

Prize

The winning video will be aired on television during Alaska Safe Boating Week, May 21-27, 2016.

Contest Guidelines

1. Open to Alaskans, age five through 18 years old.
2. Videos should be no longer than one minute in length.
3. Content must be consistent with the *Kids Don't Float* message.
4. Participants may enter up to three videos.
5. Participants are NOT to engage in risky or unsafe behavior.
6. Video must be in good taste, without objectionable language or content.
7. Video submissions become the property of the Alaska Office of Boating Safety.

Video Contest Dates

Entry period begins September 28, 2015 and ends November 30, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. The winning video will be announced on December 14, 2015.

How to Enter

Entry forms and a media release must be completed, signed by parent/guardian, and returned before filming begins.

Email entry forms and video submissions to iris.nawiesniak@alaska.gov or upload to a flash drive or DVD and mail it to Iris Nawiesniak at 550 West 7th Ave., Suite 1380 Anchorage, Alaska 99051. Once the video has been received, reviewed for content, and approved by the Alaska Office of Boating Safety it will be uploaded to Alaska Boating Safety Program's Facebook page.

Judging

Alaska Office of Boating Safety staff will select three finalists based on content, creativity, and quality. The finalist's video submissions will then go to a public vote on Facebook between the dates of December 4-11, 2015. The winning video will be announced on December 14, 2015.

Alaska Office of Boating Safety has the right to disqualify any entries that do not meet the contest criteria, or for other reasons as determined by the Alaska Office of Boating Safety at its sole discretion.

Evaluation Criteria

Content: Accurate KDF information.

Creativity: The message is presented in a clear, unique, but accurate way.

Quality: Composition, lighting, sound, and picture quality.

All entries become the property of the Alaska Office of Boating Safety and will not be returned. Participants are advised to keep a copy of their submission. By participating in the contest each participant agrees to abide by the rules, including all eligibility requirements.
