Apart from labor expenses, only expenditures for fuel, automotive fluids, or equipment parts will be eligible for reimbursement. **All** potential expenses must be clearly identified in the project budget submitted with this form to be eligible for reimbursement.

- A detailed budget. Excel or Word format. List the items and costs specifically that you
 are seeking approval to spend this contract award funding on. Items not on the budget
 cannot be approved and cannot be reimbursed.

Important Information

- Funds for grooming activities for FY20 will be available no earlier than November 15,
 2019
- Periodic trail evaluations may be conducted throughout the season to ensure compliance with specifications outlined in the grooming contract.
- Monthly reporting will now be required whether you have groomed or not.
- All reimbursement requests must be turned in by April 30, 2020 in order to be processed.
- All correspondence regarding this grooming request or the program should be directed to the email address below.
- The final funding amounts for the grooming pool trail system will be based on total mileage requests received in FY20 applied to the available funding collected for disbursement.

All applications and their required attachments must be received or postmarked no later than October 18, 2019 at 12:00pm. Applications received after this deadline will not be considered. Completed forms and attachments must be submitted via email or by mail to the appropriate addresses below.
