- When can I expect to hear if my grant was awarded? ~October
- Is the public welcome at the SnowTRAC meeting where the funding is discussed? Yes
- Where can I get the information about the meeting? There will be a News Release posted on the ADNR website, the DPOR website, and on the State Trails Program website. You may also call 907-269-8699.
- How much can I request if I am applying for a Safety, or Development and Maintenance grant?
 \$15,000
- If I am applying for a Development and Maintenance grant will match be required? How much?
 Yes, 25%
- If I am applying for a Safety grant will match be required? No
 - Please see definition of a Safety Grant before applying.
- Is match required if I am applying for money to groom trails that are in the Grooming Pool? No
- Will I be required to detail my expenses and submit them with my reimbursement request when I apply for money from the Grooming Pool? Yes
- **NEW** Can I apply to add trails to the Grooming Pool? Yes- use the application to add a trail. You no longer have to complete a full project application.
 - All trails in the Grooming Pool must have established legal access prior to joining the Pool.

- Why wasn't my Grooming Pool application awarded the whole amount asked for? Available funds vary from year to year depending upon the amount of money from registrations that is collected by the DMV; usually the total is around \$215,000, which supports the entire program including 12% charge to pay for administration of the program. The available money is divided among all applications by recommendation from the SnowTRAC and approval by the Director.
