Site improvements underway at Birch Lake State Recreation Site

(Fairbanks, AK) – Replacement of the Birch Lake State Recreation Site boat ramp is scheduled to begin August 13 and conclude August 30. During this time, the boat launch will be closed.

Funding for the project comes from the Federal Aid in Sport Fish Restoration Act, commonly referred to as the Dingell-Johnson Act. In addition to the boat launch a new outhouse will be added to the site.
