Description of feature (physical shape, length, width, direction of flow, etc.):

The island is oval shaped east-west, with a sharp point at the west end. It is just under 500' in length and approximately 125' in width. It lies in Surf Bay, approximately 1.5 miles off the west coast of Akun Island. It is approximately 6.5 miles northeast of the village of Akutan on Akutan Island. There is a smaller island less than 1,000' east of the island.

Name information such as origin, meaning of the recommended name, historical significance, biographic data (if commemorative), nature of usage or application, or any other pertinent information:

Submitted via the U.S. Board on Geographic Names, this proposal is to apply the new name "Tammo Island" meaning "little one" in the Dutch province of Groningen, to an unnamed one-acre island located off the coast of Akun Island, in Surf Bay, in Aleutians East County and the Alaska Maritime National Wildlife Refuge. The Mountaineering Club of Alaska has no objection to the proposal.

Is there local opposition to, or conflict with the recommended name (as located)?

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service notes that the island is immediately adjacent to the village of Akutan, which was not consulted by the proposer, and suggests that there may be a traditional name for the island among the local residents. The USFWS also notes that there is value to having unnamed islands in the area. The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) concurs about local consultation and notes that the name has no local connection.

For proposed new name, please provide evidence that feature is unnamed: There is no record of Tammo Island in the GNIS. There is no name for the island on the USGS 1:25,000 topo map Unimak A-5 NW (2020).

Additional information: The proposer is a native of the Netherlands who initially proposed the name "Braaams Island" for the feature. Upon being told by the USBGN that features could not be named after the proposer, he revised the proposal to Tammo Island. "Tammo" means "little one" in the Dutch province of Groningen.
