057	<p>Page 20, Paragraph 2, Sentence 1: Two suggested edits. Delete "(SCORP)" because the acronym is not used and therefore unnecessary. Remove it from the glossary too.</p> <p>Spell out acronym ATV. Use OHV with it to cross agency protocols. Add these acronyms to the glossary.</p> <p>Sounds petty, but in Northern Area, DOT insists on being written as DOT&PF (you're missing the "&" - not a slash). Change in the glossary too.</p> <p>Delete "(SAGA)." It's not used, so we don't need to add the acronym. Delete from glossary?</p> <p>Delete "(NAI)." It's not used, so we don't need to add the acronym. Delete from glossary?</p>
067	<p>Leadership Team- Consists of the division director, park superintendents and program managers. Where is the presence of Alaska residents? We need to have the residents of Alaska represented at the leadership level.</p>
080	<p>I do recognize that the majority of the people may use the state park system for recreation, and it may be that use of "sustainable" in Recreation Goal on p. 8 may be one method of partially addressing my concern above. Perhaps "sustainable" could be defined somewhere and should include the sustainability of the natural resources, not just the facilities. I'm thinking in terms of how many people some parking lots and trails may be able to handle without eroding or excessive impacts on vegetation. Some people may not understand the concept, as became obvious at a recent meeting including motorized and non-motorized trail users. Some of the issues are a matter of education.</p>
