



# Bear Baiting in The Chena River State Recreation Area



**Bear Baiting**: is allowed in the CRSRA and subject to all baiting requirements specified by the Alaska Dept. of Fish & Game. State Park regulations prohibit the following:



- No bait station may be placed within ¼ mile of a road or trail.
- No bait station may be placed within 1 mile of a house, permanent dwelling, a developed recreational facility or campground (see back of sheet for more details).
- Permanent structures are prohibited.
- Disturbing, damaging, or removing natural materials, signs, or facilities is prohibited.
- Cutting of live or dead standing trees is prohibited.
- Highway vehicles are prohibited except on State highways or Park access roads.
- The use of ATVs or other off-road vehicles is only permitted on designated trails.
- Bear baiting materials must be carried by man or animal power and placed at least ¼ mile from designated trail.
- Motorized off-road vehicles must have more than one drive wheel or track, and be no wider than 64". The vehicle must have a gross weight of less than 1500 pounds or exert less than 8 pounds per square inch ground pressure.
- The discharge of weapons for lawful hunting or trapping is allowed, **except** within ¼ mile of a developed facility, campground, trailhead, or cabin.
- Please be cautious of and courteous to other recreation users.
- You **must** remove bait, litter, stand, equipment, and any other materials from the bait site when hunting is completed. This includes any contaminated soil.
