Please begin considering the quantities and varieties of Nuclear (N) seed potatoes you would like to request from the Plant Materials Center (PMC) for planting in 2027. To support our 2026 greenhouse production planning, we will accept order requests through January 31, 2026.

We encourage growers to renew their seed stocks regularly with disease-free Nuclear seed from the PMC to ensure continued production of high-quality potatoes across Alaska. Maintaining clean seed is essential to sustaining industry-wide health, and we are committed to supporting you with the healthiest planting material possible.

Enclosed you will find our current variety lists. If you do not see a variety that meets your needs, please contact us—we may be able to produce it or suggest a comparable alternative. Due to production logistics, the minimum order is two pounds per variety, and the price is \$15.00 per pound. Orders may be submitted by fax, phone, mail, email, or through the online order form provided. Please send all orders by January 31, 2026 to ensure adequate production time.

Please note that orders cannot be accepted from growers with outstanding balances. If you are unsure of your account status, feel free to contact the PMC office at (907) 745-4469 for confirmation. We appreciate your attention to this requirement.
