John Hilsinger: Izembek Wildlife Refuge – Management by “bluff” concerns.

Ray Kreig: Locate Federal Oversight Summit Videos and post. Clarified CACFA mission as sole advocate of ANILCA issues for private Alaska citizens.

Jenn Yuhass: Actionable items that CACFA can work on, predator management, eliminate incompatible use.

Dick Bishop: navigability issues, access and fisheries management

Mary Bishop: Defined avulsion vs. meander; if river avulsed after Statehood, is new channel considered to be navigable?

Mike Quinn: open seat question, federal service shortage, agency communication not standardized

Tina Cuning: RDI Process, PAD Unit.

Reid Harris: Strategic hiring initiative with BLM, RDI Process, favorable of AK State Dir. Pendergast.

Sara Taylor: request for backup database of CACFA to be stored at ARLIS.
