Nominations Open for 2025 Farm Family of the Year

(Palmer, AK) – The Alaska Division of Agriculture invites the public to submit nominations for the 26th annual Farm Family of the Year Award. The award was established in 2000 to honor an Alaska farm family that epitomizes the spirit of the industry, and to show appreciation for hardworking Alaskans committed to agriculture and aquaculture. With support from the Matanuska Valley Federal Credit Union and the Alaska State Fair, the yearly process features farmers being nominated by their peers.

The winning Farm Family of the Year will be presented with the award at this year's Alaska State Fair in Palmer, Alaska, during the Director's Reception on opening day. In addition, the farm family will be highlighted on the <u>Alaska Grown Facebook</u> channel to recognize and thank them for their contributions to Alaska's agriculture industry.

Nominations should include details about the family and how they fulfill the criteria:

- Production of quality Alaska Grown products
- Community involvement, such as civic organizations, schools, sports, and churches, etc.
- Involvement in agriculture industry organizations, including local, state, and federal organizations
- Overall farm family image, farming history, and unique or special production
